“The Magic of Summer”

June 15 - 19

Discover the art of MAGIC with our Special “Magician Guest”. He will teach your children how to perform magic tricks. We will also have magical field trips, cooking magic, and art and science magic! We will end our week with a Magic Show prepared by the kids.

“OMSI Science Week - Whales, the giants of the Ocean”

June 22 – 26

OMSI (Oregon Museum of Science and Industry) will be here for this camp

Students will marvel at these enormous creatures as they crawl inside a 40 or 60 foot, life-size, inflatable whale. Young marine biologists will take a close-up look at the whales and Dolphins, examining baleen and learning about communication, feeding, behaviors, and various species of these amazing mammals. Topics: anatomy, behavior, whale ecology. Includes the exploration of bugs, bats, sounds and microscopes!

June 29 - July 3

Discover the WILD WEST! Horses and horse care, field trips to the Discovery Center and to the Saddle Club in Hood River. Country Music, western cooking, Smokey the Bear, and American Crafts. We will watch as the horses are being prepared for the Hood River 4th of July parade!

July 6 - 10

We will rock the week with Victor and Steve! Singing songs, making instruments and recording our own music. We will end the week with a Rock Concert. Our field trip will be to Eclipse Music Center where the children will have hands on experiences with various instruments. “Mosaics - Art week with Shelly Toon Hight”

July 13 - 17

We will make a Mosaic Mural in the foyer at Bambinos with Shelly Toon Hight. Come and enjoy learning the Mosaics technique by creating a mural in the Bambinos Main Lobby. The children will experience other art forms such as paper making, paper-mache, pastel, oil, water color, photography and lots of other cool art projects. We will end our week with a Children's Art Show!
